

# 5th Grade Mystery Song #3 - Can you figure it out???

Hint: This song is from a movie and musical. It uses all F-Naturals and C-Naturals, instead of F-Sharp and C-Sharp. This is called "Low 2" for Violin and Viola. Cellos use 2nd finger for these notes. Bases play C-Natural by shifting to 1st finger, instead of 2nd finger. Have fun!

## VIOLIN:
